WHY 28 JANUARY ?

Anniversary of the signing of Council of Europe Convention No. 108

PRINCIPLES & GUARANTEES

- Free exchange of data while respecting human dignity.
- High levels of transparency in data processing.
- Respecting privacy at the design stage of IT systems.

CONVENTION 108

- 1st and ONLY binding international instrument.
- Respect for the right to privacy and data protection.

OBJECTIVE: Raising public awereness

- Personal data protection, rights and tools.
- Right to privacy.
- Information for all.

Protection of personal data in Monaco

1993 : Law no. 1.165 passed

2008 : Accession to Convention 108 and reform of Law no. 1.165

2018 : Signature of Convention 108+ (modernised convention)

2021 : Bill no. 1.054 on personal data

2023 : 30 years of Law no. 1.165

Independent Control Authority CCIN

Protection based on:

- The digital economy,
- Cross-border data flows,
- Intensified use of technological resources.

BILL 1.054

Major reform:

- Transcription of Convention 108+.
- Harmonisation with the provisions of the GDPR and the "Police -Justice" Directive.

Objective = to facilitate transfers of personal data between the EU and Monaco





Take control of your data

Constant sharing of personal data: voluntary and involuntary

<u>Examples</u>: create an account on an e-commerce site, accept cookies from a site,.... Realise that **your data belongs to you.**

Be aware of your rights: the law protects you... children, teenagers and adults alike.

Avoid disclosing ancillary information: don't give your full date of birth to all the sites, and don't allow the sites to remember your bank details...

Do not authorise all cookies: some track all your actions. Most sites allow you to choose the "essential cookies only" option. Choose SEVERAL strong passwords.

Go to the CCIN website (practical information sheets, advice, podcast, complaint forms, etc.), which can act on request, including from minors directly.
